





# House in the Wild

Location	House in the Wild is located in Enonkishu Conservancy, on the northern edge of the Maasai Mara ecosystem.
Altitude & Climate	1,700 metres / 5,750ft above sea level.
Rooms	7 luxury cottages:
	Marula (2 ensuite bedrooms) – bathtub, indoor & outdoor shower Original (2 ensuite bedrooms) – bathtub & outdoor shower Kisaru (2 ensuite bedrooms) – bathtub, indoor & outdoor shower River (1 ensuite bedroom) – bathtub & indoor shower Warburgia (1 ensuite bedroom) – bathtub, indoor & outdoor shower Hippo (1 ensuite bedroom) – bathtub & indoor shower Olerai (1 ensuite bedroom) – bathtub & outdoor shower

Room Amenities	Mosquito nets, pure cotton linen, dressing gowns, room safe, square pin plug socket, torch, drinking water, wild journal, writing desk.
Bathroom Amenities	Shower gel, shampoo, conditioner, soap, laundry detergent (for under garments), towels, make-up mirror.
Layout	Main living area with lounge, verandah, bar and dining room, pool gazebo, shop, photo studio, and spa tent and 7 accommodation cottages.
