

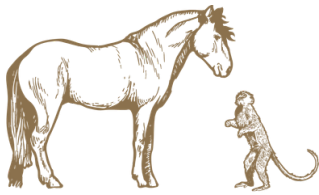
HORSES IN THE WILD

Our gentle, experienced horses are ready to provide guests with an unforgettable experience, offering a unique perspective of the stunning African landscape while interacting with wildlife. Rides are best enjoyed early in the morning, culminating in a delightful champagne breakfast, or in the afternoon, ending with refreshing sundowners.



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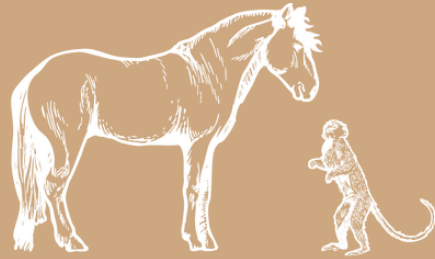
MAASAI MARA

Location	Our stables are at the Mara Training Centre, in the Wild Hub, our rides take place in the Enonkishu conservancy
Altitude	1,700 metres / 5,750Ft Above sea level
Horses	16 mixed breed well trained and responsive safari horses
	Weight limit of 85 kgs
Maximum Guests	6 riders
Stables	Open plan stable yard
Ability	We take experienced riders only in the Conservancy Beginners are welcome on lead rein rides around the farm
Rides	Soft terrain, rides in open plains of Enonkishu and through some forested tracks.
Special Features	Comfortable high quality saddles and equipment.
Child Policy	Competent children over 12 can join rides in the conservancy. Younger children can do rides around the farm
Lead rein	Smaller children can do leading rein around the stables
Saddles	Special safari “paddle” saddles

Breeds	Thoroughbred, Percheron, Friesian mix
Ride times	7.00 am - 11 am: including bush breakfast 4.00 pm - 7.00 pm: including a special sundowners
Guides	Our horseriding guides will accompany all rides
Seasons	Open year round
Climate	There is a warm climate throughout the year
Post Ride	Celebrate the ride with a champagne bush breakfast or a special sundowner
Photography	We can organise a photographer for an extra \$150 to accompany the ride in a car
Wild life encounters	Our horses are used to wildlife but we can get close to giraffe and other plains game. We occasionally encounter elephant, buffalo and the big cats
Terrain	Grassy plains, murrain tracks, forested areas of Enonkishu
Ride types	Walks, trots and gentle canters
Support car	We have a support car close by in case of any need
Helmets	Compulsory and we have helmets to lend
Chaps	We can lend chaps to all riders

Longer rides	These can be available on request
Tipping	Yes, cash or QR code on site
Other lodges	We can offer rides to anyone across the Mara (see rates)
Collection	We can provide collection / drop off to other lodges at a fee
Direct Transfer time from Airstrip	Naretoi: 5 mins Ngerende: 15 Mins Mara North: 1 hour
CITW	All guests staying at Collection in the Wild have riding included (except for Bandas, where riding is excluded)
Naretoi	Naretoi homeowners can buy bulk package rides
Accommodation	We have a variety of accommodation options at our properties
Safari Car Types	Toyota Landcruisers, Landrovers Open
Malaria	We are in a LOW RISK malaria area
