THE LAMU EXPERIENCE:

Lamu moves at a gloriously relaxed pace, inviting travellers to slow down, walk barefoot on golden sands, watch dhows sail languidly by, and feast on delicious seafood caught fresh each day. The mix of African and Arabic cultures date back hundreds of years and are seen in everything from the architecture to the food.

Our Wild Lamu properties are found on the peaceful southern tip of Lamu Island, on Kizingoni Beach. This is the East African coast experience many people dream of - an unspoilt coastline, warm waters to swim in, some of the friendliest people you will ever meet, and a deep-rooted history which adds warmth and intrigue to those looking to explore.

During your stay with us, we include stand up paddleboarding, sea kayaking and an hour of snorkelling or fishing per day, in and around the local bay. We can gladly arrange additional activities as shown here, which will be added to your bill on departure.

IN-VILLA MASSAGE:

Wind down and ease away any tensions from your travels with a soothing 1 hour massage in the comfort of your villa.

DHOW SUNSET OR SUNRISE SAIL:

Set sail from the beach right outside your villa in a private dhow, cruising gently under the breeze. Enjoy sundowner drinks and snacks as you drift along the water, watching birds return to roost for the night as the sun sets. The dhow is also available for a sunrise sail, at the same rate, or for longer bespoke journeys e.g. to Shela or sandbanks. Please enquire with us for options.

KITE SURFING LESSONS:

The tradewinds off the coast of Lamu lend themselves perfectly to kite-surfing, between December - February, and July-September. Lessons can be tailored to suit your level of experience, with qualified instructors and high quality kit.

DEEP-SEA FISHING:

Head to the deep ocean off Lamu, departing from Shela (a 1 hour boat ride from your Wild Villa) in search of trevelly, kingfish, marlin and more. Suitable for all abilities. Fishing spots and catches depend on the season and tradewinds. Available as a half or full day excursion.

SPEEDBOAT FUN:

The sheltered channels along the north-western shore of Lamu Island lend themselves wonderfully to watersports such as waterskiing and tubing. Fishing rods are available for guest use, and we can pack a coolbox with drinks and snacks if you head out for a morning or afternoon.

SHELA VILLAGE AND LAMU OLD TOWN:

Just an hour's boat ride from your villa lies the charming Shela village, where you'll find no cars, just a maze of cobbled and sandy streets. There are some delightful small shops to explore, simple, local cafes and restaurants to discover and getting lost in the streets, passing donkeys and cats is part of the experience. We can arrange a guide or simply arrange a pick-up time.

Nearby is Lamu Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage site, brimming with fascinating stories from its varied history over the centuries. Explore workshops where the intricately carved Swahili doors are carved by hand, a skill passed down through the generations. A guide is well worth booking here to make the most of your explorations.
